Ambassador's Category of Young People under 25 including Students

ROLE & RESPONSILITIES:

1. Represent DMWD at nominated events and functions at various local, state and national venues.
2. Create awareness of DMWD objectives & influence outcomes both internally & externally.
3. Provide leadership, commitment and integrity of DMWD values.
4. Chair/ participate in local, state or national committees as scheduled and required from time to time.
5. No minimum or maximum time requirements. DMWD is flexible and understands of every individual's availability for such a role.

NOMINATION / APPLICATION PROCESS & APPOINTMENT, TRAINING:

1. Complete nomination/application form.
2. Suitability assessment by DMWD PANEL. An appointment letter will be issued if selected.
3. Complete DMWD Ambassador induction program.
4. Complete DMWD AMBASSADOR PROGRAMS Module 1 & module 2 within 6 months of appointment.
5. Complete Annual refresher program.

REMUNERATION, T&C, BENEFITS, ALLOWANCES, OTHER:

1. These are volunteer roles and no remuneration is paid.
2. Term is for initial 2 years and renewed annually thereafter.
3. Travel & meals allowance may be payable.
4. If self employed, unemployed or student or pensioner, then some compensation may be considered to offset some out of pockets expenses / hardship.
5. If employed and unable to take off with pay from existing employer then DMWD will consider some compensation in lieu which is considered reasonable by DMWD. Refer Guidelines.
6. Allocation of DMWD merchandise for distribution to individuals mentored and their family & friends based on needs.
